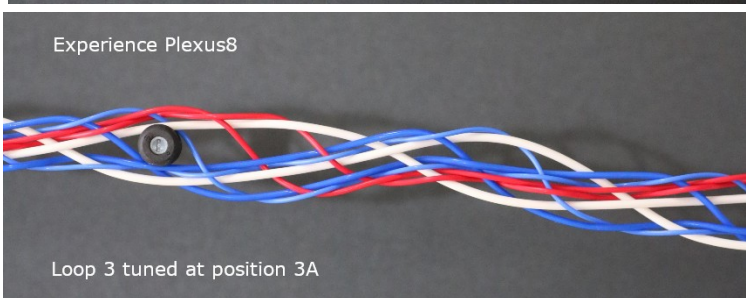
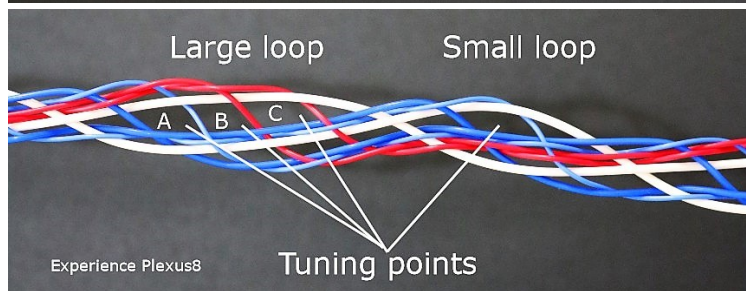
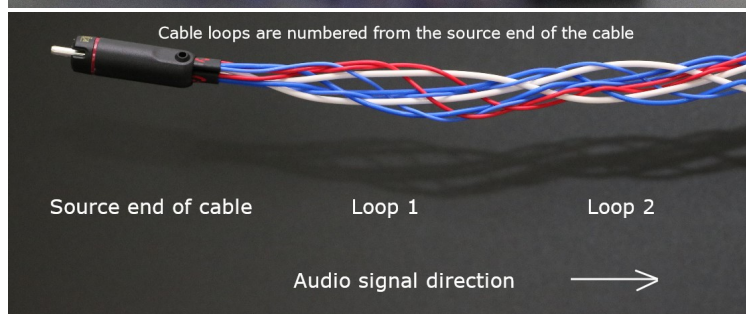
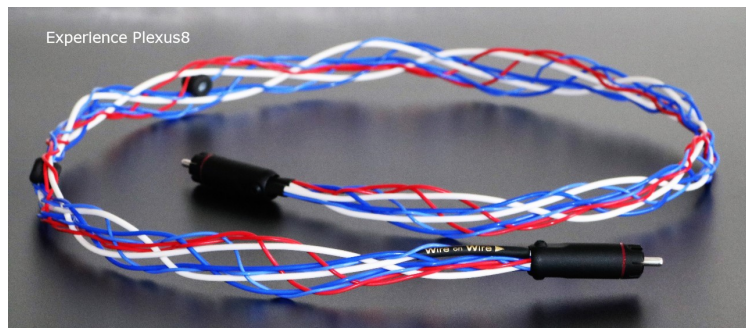


The Experience Plexus8 RCA

Tuneable RCA audio cable

Tuning guide



Loop	Listening notes
2	Solid musical images. Darker presentation.
3B	Slightly more image depth than 3C.
3C	Musical images move back. Increase in clarity / air and space.
5A	Musical images move closer. Increase in clarity.
6	Solid images with firmer leading edges.
7B	Musical images move closer. Warmth and clarity.
9B	Increase in air and space with firmer leading edges.

The Experience Plexus8 RCA audio interconnect

is a state of the art, tuneable cable consisting of 8 sets of wires, braided using Wire on Wire’s patented REDpurl™ Adaptive Asymmetric Geometry. All cables are made to order and constructed by hand.

The cable’s Plexus8 geometry creates an alternating set of large and small loops. These loops are framed by the two large white conductors. Within these loops ‘spacers’ can be inserted as shown, to modify the electrical properties of the cable and fine-tune the cables to allow better matching between audio components.

To begin exploring your system’s potential, take some time to listen to the cables without any tuning.

Listening notes

When you are ready to tune please note that loop 1 or any loop connecting directly with a plug should not be tuned.

The notes shown in the table are based on a single tuning ‘spacer’ being inserted at a specific loop.

Combinations of loops are not shown here but feel free to experiment.

The cable is designed to fine-tune an audio system with minimal tuning so we suggest trying each of the following before experimenting further: 3B, 5A and 7B.

Your ears and your audio components make for a unique combination so use whatever tuning works for you and don’t be bound by our recommendations.
